#### Boarding Isolation Procedure

At this time, Coronavirus 19 has not been confirmed in Tanzania. However, we must remain dutiful in following the government's updates. In the case that the disease should be confirmed, the following isolation protocol will be observed and will apply to any student who develops a high fever and a cough until and of the following events are true:

1. a medical test confirms negative to the coronavirus
2. the student is picked up by a parent or designated caregiver
3. he student has been in isolation for 14days and has no symptoms of coronavirus 19
4. we are advised otherwise by health authorities

1. Girls will be isolated in their house: Victoria Room. Boys are to be isolated in their house: Chrysanthemum Room.
2. Once in isolation, students may not leave their room whilst other students are in the house or will be in the house within one hour.
3. Food will be served in their room by an adult wearing protective clothing.
4. Toilets and shower are located in the room.
5. If their condition worsens or becomes critical, they will be returned to hospital immediately to follow medical advice.
6. All rooms will be cleaned with disinfectant on a regular basis (a minimum of once per day).
7. Good hygiene must be observed by all, at all times including handwashing when entering the boarding facilities and throughout food preparation.

#### Procedure if any student contracts Coronavirus 19

If any student is confirmed to have Coronavirus 19, the parents or legal guardians must make direct arrangements with the hospital to get them home or to a residency which is convenient to them, in line with health authority regulations. They will not be permitted to return to the boarding hostel until the quarantine period is complete. This is to give them the best care and attention possible and to keep our other students and staff safe.
